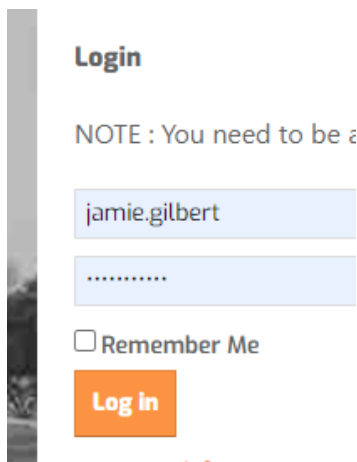
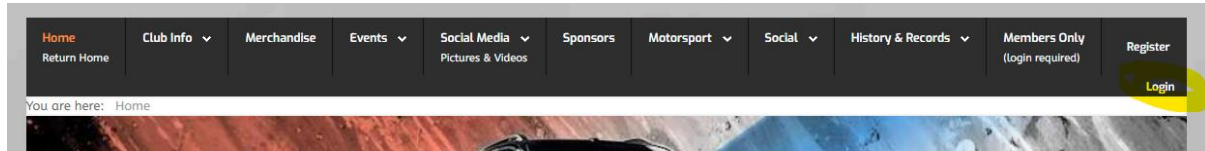
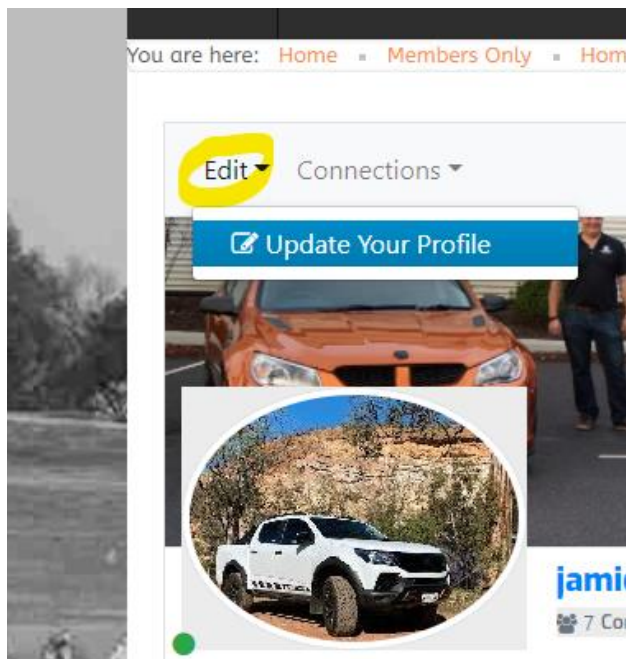


# How to - Change your Profile and uploading a motorsport licence image/file


First Login to the website



Then select the Edit menu and the "Update Your Profile"




Update the various tabs as required, for the Motorsport select the “Completion Details” tab


To upload an image for your motorsport licence
